He protects you from the devil and served you by dying on the cross for your sins so you can have eternal life.

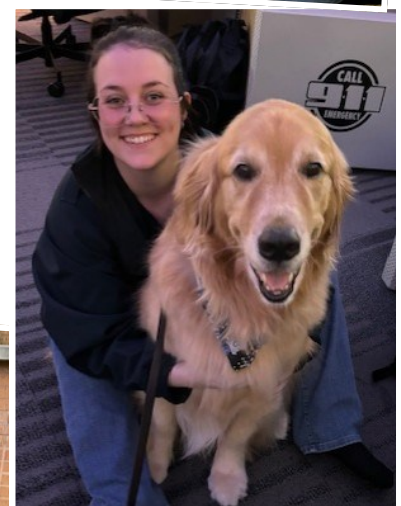
He's the greatest LEO ever!
